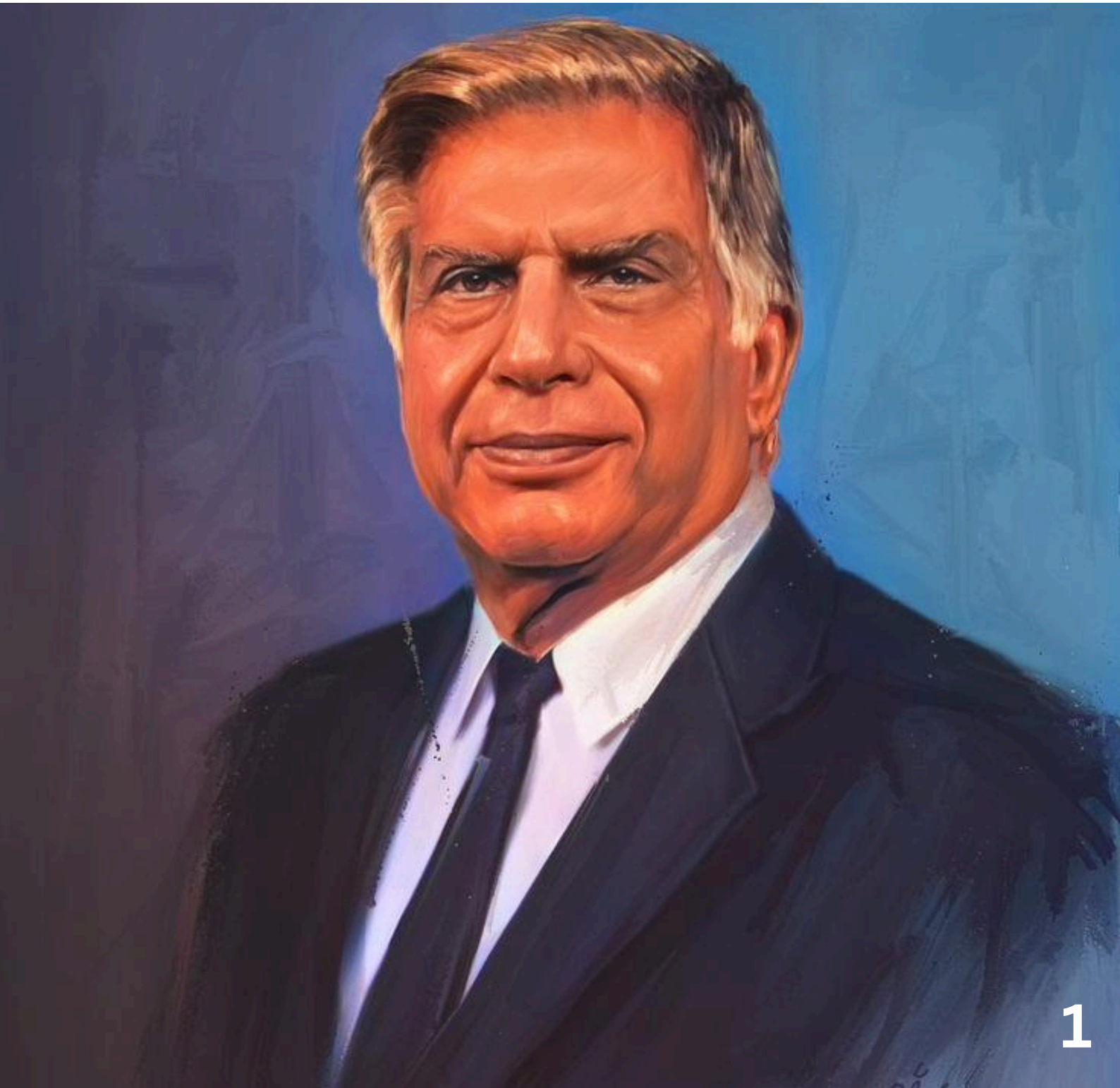

You have to MOVE ON.

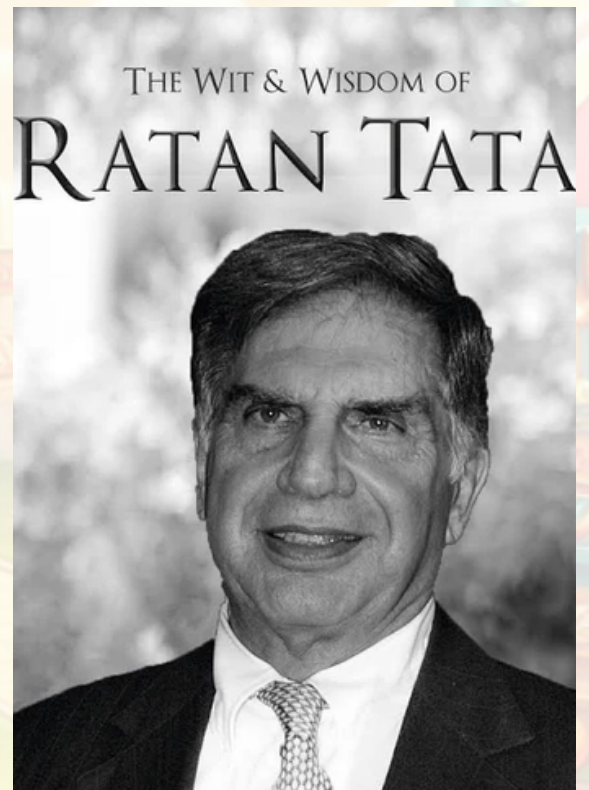

CONCEPT OF THE MONTH: VEHICLE ACTUATED CONTROL



Vehicle Actuated Control (VAC) is a traffic signal system that adjusts signal timings based on the number of vehicles approaching an intersection. VAC uses magnetic loops or cameras to count vehicles and determine the density of traffic and it can adjust the length of the green light for a stage, or skip a stage, to respond to traffic flow.
